What are some things God says about me in Christ. (with additional notes)

The following list is not a complete listing of every reference to being in Christ or in the Lord.

This list represents those things which God imputes [counts] true of us as He considers us in

Christ.

	Ephesians 1:3 - "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus
	Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual
	blessing in the heavenly places" God says all good words [blessings]
	about me in Christ. All things I have in Him are good things which God says.
	Ephesians 1:6 - "To the praise of his glorious grace, with which
	he has graced us in the Beloved." God has graced [AV "accepted," ESV
	"blessed"] me in Christ. I don't deserve Him to say any of these things.
	Especially when I understand that God graciously counts Christ's death to me,
	when I did not have to experience the suffering involved in that death. cf.
	Romans 5:2; 1 Corinthians 1:4; 1 Timothy 1:12; 2 Timothy 1:9; 2:1
	Romans 6:8, - "Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that
	we will also live with him" Galatians 2:20 - We died because we were
	crucified with Him.
r	Romans 6:11 - "So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to
	God in Christ Jesus." We died with Christ, by being counted to be in Him.
	Colossians 3:3 We are living ones towards God.

Ĺ	Romans 8:1 - "There is therefore now no condemnation for those
	who are in Christ Jesus." We are not condemned [really judged]. For
	Christ bore our judgment.
Ţ	Romans 12:5 - "so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and
	individually members one of another." All believers united together
	are one body-the body of Christ.
Ţ	1 Corinthians 12:12, 13 - "For just as the body is one and has
	many members, and all the members of the body, though
	many, are one body, so it is with Christ. 13 For in one Spirit we were
	all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made
	to drink of one Spirit." All believers united together are one body-the body of
	Christ.
Ţ	Romans 15:17 - "In Christ Jesus, then, I have a boast of my
	priestly work for God. "We have a boast in Christ because as priests we
	can do a temple work. cf 1 Corinthians 1:31; 15:31; 2 Corinthians 10:17;
	Philippians 1:26; Philippians 3:3
Ţ	orinthians 1:2 - "To the church of God that is in Corinth, to
	those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together
	with all those who in every place call upon the name of our
	Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours." We are sanctified [set
	apart to God]. By putting us in Christ, God set us apart from this world and

	placed at His right hand. Since we are sanctified, [made holy-set apart] we are
	saints [holy ones–set apart ones]. cf. Philippians 1:1; 4:21; Colossians 1:2
C]1 Corinthians 1:30 - "And because of him you are in Christ Jesus,
	who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and
	sanctification and redemption," Since, we are in Him, Christ is now
	wisdom for us. Some of God's knowledge is applied to us in Christ. We can avai
	ourselves of this wisdom as we relate to our position in Him.
Ţ]1 Corinthians 1:30 - "And because of him you are in Christ Jesus,
	who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and
	sanctification and redemption," Christ has been made righteousness
	for us. We are made God's
C	kind of righteousness in Him. 2 Corinthians 5:21 "For our sake He (the
	Father) made Him (Christ) to be sin who knew no sin, so
	that in Him we might become God's righteousness."
Ţ]1 Corinthians 9:21 - "To those outside the law I became as one
	outside the law (not being outside the law concerning God
	but in-lawed regarding Christ) that I might win those outside
	the law. "We are inlawed to Christ. In Him we can love and are not lawless.
Ţ	Galatians 2:4 - "Yet because of false brothers secretly brought in
	—who slipped in to spy out our freedom that we have in

	Christ Jesus, so that they might enslave us" We have liberty in
	Christ. We have been set free from the Law.
Ţ	Romans 7:4 - "Likewise, my brothers, you also have died to the
	law through the body of Christ, so that you may belong to
	another, to Him who has been raised from the dead, in order
	that we may bear fruit for God." We have been set free from the Law,
	by dying with Christ in the body of Christ.
Ţ	Romans 8:2 - "For the principle of the Spirit of life has freed you
	in Christ Jesus from the principle of sin and death."
	Galatians 3:26 - "for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God,
	through faith."
C	Galatians 3:28 - "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither
	slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one
	in Christ Jesus."We are not distinguished as to race [Jew or Gentile],
	status [slave or free], sex [male or female], we are one! cf. Colossians 3:11;
	Ephesians 3:6. As a result physical circumcision or the lack of it does not count
	for anything (or "make anything strong") Galatians 5:6
Ĺ	Ephesians 1:7 - "In him we have redemption through his blood,
	the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of
	his grace," We have complete redemption [purchased and set free] cp
	Colossians 1:14; Romans 3:24

	TEphesians 1:7 - "In him we have redemption through his blood,
	the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of
	his grace," We have our trespasses [offenses in action or choice] sent away
	[forgiven]. Our sins are also forgiven, for which see Colossians 1:14
	Ephesians 1:11 - "In him we have obtained an inheritance,
	having been predestined according to the purpose of him who
	works all things according to the counsel of his will, "We were
	made an inheritance for Christ in Christ. Think about that. God made you something which Christ inherited.
	Ephesians 1:13 - "In him you also, when you heard the word of
	truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were
	sealed with the promised Holy Spirit," We are sealed into Him by the
	Holy Spirit. We cannot be removed from our position in Him.
	Ephesians 2:4-5 - "But God, being rich in mercy, because of the
	great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead by means
	of our trespasses, He made us alive together with Christ–by grace you have
	been saved—"The "together in Christ" emphasizes a shared standing with all
	who believe in Christ. No believer is seen as better or worse than any other in
	Christ. cf. Romans 6:11
Ĺ	Ephesians 2:6 - "and raised us up with him and seated us with
	him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus," We are raised
	[resurrected] from a state of death.

C	Colossians 2:12 - We have been raised together with Him. 3:1 "Since then
	you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are
	above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God."
	Ephesians 2:6 - "and raised us up with him and seated us with
	him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus," We are seated together
	in the heavenlies. Christ sat down at the right hand of the Father and we are
	seated in Him. Think of it, seated by God and in God.
Ţ	Ephesians 2:13 - "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far
	off have been brought near by the blood of Christ." We are made
	near to God. We were far away but now, seated in Christ we are very near to
	God.
Ţ	Ephesians 2:15 - "by abolishing the law of commandments
	expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one
	new man in place of the two, so making peace," We have been
	created together with others whether from the Gentiles or the Jews, into One
	New Man. cf Ephesians 2:10;
Ţ	2 Corinthians 5:17 - "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, a new
	creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has
	come." This is called the New Creation and is one man, not new men.
	Galatians 6:15

C	Ephesians 2:21-22 - "in Whom the whole structure, being joined
	together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In Him you also are
	being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit." We, with all
	believers of the Church, are being built into a spiritual house, a dwelling place
	of God.
C	Ephesians 3:6 - "This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow
	heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the
	promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel." We [the Gentiles] are
	absolutely equal heirs with the Jews [not the nation of Israel] who are now in
	the body. Simply, Jews saved today, do not have something better than the
	Gentile who is saved today. They have an equal status, in fact they have
	ceased to be either Jew or Gentile in Christ. Jews and Gentiles are of the very
	same body and equal partakers. cf. Galatians 3:28
	Tephesians 3:12 - "This was according to the eternal purpose that
	he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness
	and access with confidence through our faith in him." We have boldness and
	access. By Him, we have access to the Father (2:18). He is seated by the Father.
	He is in the Father. So we have a close access to the Father. cf. Philemon 8
C	Philippians 3:3 - "For we are the circumcision, who worship by
	the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no
	confidence in the flesh— "We have a priestly service we may perform
	in Christ (see Romans 15:17).

C	Colossians 1:14 - "He has <u>delivered us from the domain of</u>
	darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved
	Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." We have our sins
	sent away [forgiven]. Since we are redeemed, the penalty is paid for and the
	sin is sent away. This is the result of complete redemption. cf. Ephesians 4:32
Ĺ	Colossians 2:8-10 - "See to it that no one takes you captive by
	philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition,
	according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not
	according to Christ. For in Him the whole fullness of deity
	dwells bodily, and you have been filled full in Him, who is the
	head of all rule and authority." We were made the fullness. Fullness
	refers to the complete full grown New Man comprised of all believers in the
	Church, united to Jesus Christ the Head.
Ţ	Colossians 2:11 - "In Him also you were circumcised with a
	circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of
	the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ," We, males and females,
	have been spiritually circumcised, having been cut off from the body
	dominated by the flesh [sin nature]. cf. Philippians 3:3
Ţ	Colossians 2:12 - "having been buried with him in baptism, in
	which you were also raised with him through faith in the
	powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead." We

have been buried together with Him. This is not water baptism, but the baptism from the Spirit which places us in Christ. cf Romans 6:3-4 Colossians 2:20 - "If with Christ you died to the elemental things of the world, why, as if you were still living in the world, do you submit to regulations - 'Do not handle, Do not taste, Do not touch' (referring to things that all perish as they are used)—according to human precepts and teachings?" We died with Christ to the basic elements of the world system. The Law is part of the elements (cf Galatians 4:9). The restrictions reflect the life of the immature living under the basic principles of this system. 1 Thessalonians 1:1 - "Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace. "We are in the Father. Christ is in the Father and since we are in Him, we are also in the Father. Therefore, positionally, we also have an intimate relationship to the Father. John 14:20 - "In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you." John 17:21-23 - "that they may all be one thing, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be one thing in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one thing even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become

matured into one thing, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me." The "one thing" is the body of Christ, the new man, where no differences between believers exist.

Colossians 2:1-2 - "For I want you to know how great a struggle I have for you and for those at Laodicea and for all who have not seen me face to face, that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of the mystery concerning God even the Father and the Christ"

Believers are in one thing-the body-in the Father and in the Son. When believers are relating to that truth, it affects them by knitting their hearts together in love. Mentally appreciating the unified position has a practical affect in believers' relationships with one another.
